Milton Public Library is thrilled to host CBC Canada Reads 2020 Winner, **Samra Habib Monday, January I I at 7pm** for a special culminating 2020 **One Book, One Milton** virtual event.

Samra Habib is a writer, photographer, and activist. As a journalist she's covered topics ranging from fashion trends and Muslim dating apps to the rise of Islamophobia in the US. Her writing has appeared in *The New York Times*, *The Guardian*, and *The Advocate*, and her photo project, "Just Me and Allah," has been featured in *Nylon*, *i-D*, *Vanity Fair Italia*, *Vice*, and *The Washington Post*. She works with LGBTQIA organizations internationally, raising awareness of issues that impact queer Muslims around the world.


She will take to the virtual stage to discuss her brand new book, We Have Always Been Here, Monday, January I I at 7pm. We Have Always Been Here is a national bestseller, won a Lambda Literary Award, and was the winner of CBC Canada Reads 2020. The exciting online event will be hosted by Michael Serapio of the CBC News Network and the captivating pair are expected to deliver an entertaining evening.
